

Environmental Assessment (EA)

- Summary of Findings:
 - Short-term construction-related impacts, to be addressed through Best Management Practices (BMPs)
 - No significant adverse long-term impacts
 - Overall beneficial long-term impacts to transportation, public health, and the State's environmental goals
- Based on findings of the Final EA, a Finding of No Significant Impact (FONSI) was determined by DTS.


