

HOW TO REGISTER A BICYCLE

Registering a “Pedal” Bicycle



All bicycles having two tandem wheels that are twenty inches (20”) or more in diameter are required to be registered.

Bicycles with less than twenty inches (20”) in diameter are not required to be registered but owners of such bicycles may pay the permanent registration fee to facilitate the return of recovered stolen bicycles.

Initial “Pedal” Bicycle Registration Requirements

- Must be at least 18 years of age
- Bicycle/Moped Application for Registration
- Statement of Fact Bicycle/Moped Ownership
- Fee: \$15.00

Registering an “Electric” Bicycle

All low-speed electric bicycles with fully operable pedals and an electric motor of less than 750 watts (1 h.p.), whose maximum speed is less than 20 mph are required to be registered.

Riders under the age of 15 years are **prohibited** from operating an electric bicycle.

Initial “Electric” Bicycle Registration Requirements

- Must be at least 18 years of age
- Bicycle/Moped Application for Registration
Note: when registering low speed electric bicycles, you must indicate the WATTS on the application. (next to H.P.)
- Statement of Fact Bicycle/Moped Ownership
- Electric watts signed “statement”
- Fee: \$30.00

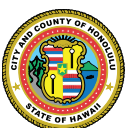
