Objectives

Goal 1:

Hawaii's older adults have opportunities to livewell.

(ACL Topic Area: OAA/Title III Core Programs)

Objective statements:

- 1. Promote awareness and education on the importance of planning to age in place.**
- 2. Increase opportunities in the community for older adults and caregivers to participate and engage in programs and services to age well. Encourage growth of community capacity to provide services.**
- 3. Increase opportunities in the community for older adults and caregivers to participate and engage in programs and services to address social isolation.**

Goal 2:

Hawaii's older adults are prepared for future health threats and disasters.
(ACL Topic Area: COVID-19)

Objective statements:

- 1. Educate older adults and their caregivers on the importance of having an emergency plan in place.**
- 2. Provide information to older adults and their caregivers on disaster preparedness resources.**

Goal 3:

Hawaii's underserved populations have equitable access to programs and services.

(ACL Topic Area: Equity)

Objective statement:

- 1. Increase accessibility of programs and services to underserved populations.**

Goal 4:

Hawaii's older adults and people with disabilities will age in place.
(ACL Topic Area: Expanding Access to HCBS)

Objective statements:

- 1.** Increase accessibility of services for older adults and persons with disabilities to age in place.
- 2.** Promote HCBS programs to support older adults to age in place.
- 3.** Promote HCBS programs to support persons with disabilities to age in place.

Goal 5:

Hawaii's caregivers have a broad array of services and supports to effectively care for their loved ones.

(ACL Topic Area: Caregivers)

Objective statements:

- 1. Increase awareness of services and supports for caregivers.**
- 2. Increase access to services and supports for caregivers.**
