Please call (808) 768-3585 to arrange to reclaim the impounded property. You may produce the storage and disposal notice for the impounded property or provide a description of your property and the approximate date, time, and location where it was impounded. All items stored by the City related to the notice (or as described) will be returned after execution of a receipt attesting to ownership of the impounded property.

You may reclaim your property all at once or in multiple trips (so long as all your property is reclaimed within 45 days of being impounded).

Property owner shall be responsible for all costs of removal, storage and disposition of impounded property.

IF YOU ARE HOMELESS AND CANNOT AFFORD TO PAY THE COSTS, YOU MAY RECLAIM YOUR PROPERTY WITHOUT PAYMENT UPON ATTESTING, SUBJECT TO PENALTY OF PERJURY, YOUR FINANCIAL INABILITY TO PAY.
