What is an apprenticeship?

An **apprenticeship** is a combination of on-the-job training (OJT) and related classroom instruction under the supervision of a journey-level trade professional. After completing the apprenticeship program, graduates become skilled trade workers.

What are the different skilled trades available?

Plant Electrical/Electronic Equipment Repairer	Honolulu Board of Water Supply	Installs, maintains, overhauls and repairs plant electrical and electronic control devices and equipment.	10,000 work process hours usually completed in 5 years	Industrial Electrician License
Traffic Signal Electrician	Department of Transportation Services	Installs, maintains and repairs electro-mechanical and electronic traffic signal control devices, control boxes and other necessary field equipment.	10,000 work process hours usually completed in 5 years	Electrician License

What are the requirements?

Possession of appropriate valid Hawaii State driver's license as required.

How do I apply?

- Go to the Department of Human Resource's Career page www.honolulu.gov/career and click on Permanent Jobs.
- Search for: Trades Apprentice I
- Click on the "Apply" link and complete the online application by the posted deadline

If the job announcement is *not listed* on the Permanent Jobs website, then the City is not accepting applications at this time. To receive an email notice when a recruitment for *Trades Apprentice I* opens, complete a <u>Job Interest Card</u> through our Career page. Follow the instructions and select "**Trades**". Your interest card is on file for twelve months. When the 12-month period expires, you must repeat this process to continue receiving email notices.

<u>Important</u>: The Job Interest Card is provided as a tool to help applicants in their job search. Applicants are responsible for checking the Career site for **Trades Apprentice I** recruitments.
