Public Notice is hereby provided for the following proposed transactions affecting City properties:

Property: Portion of Geiger Road, Lot B-1, Ewa, Oahu, Grant of 3 Perpetual Easements

TMKs: Portions of (1) 9-1-013 and 9-1-069 (roadways); Land Area: 34,906 square feet

Requestor: Gentry Homes, Ltd.

<u>Proposed Transaction</u>: Three Easements for improvements completed within Geiger Road. Easements 1 and 2 with a total area of 31,199 square feet is for irrigation purposes and Easement 3 with a total area of 3,707 square feet is for landscaping, a retaining wall and irrigation purposes. The retaining wall was necessary due to the difference in elevation between the road and existing adjacent residences and the irrigation system was installed to irrigate the roadway planter strips.

DOFAW currently manages, maintains and develops all the parcels in the Sanctuary under a license agreement with the City.
