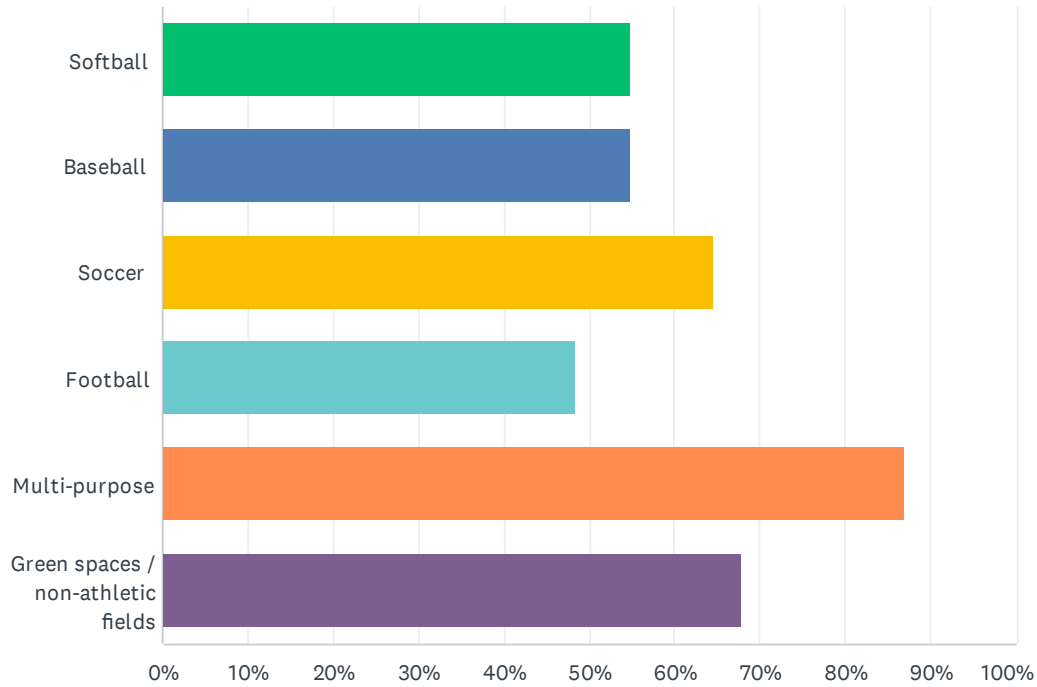


## Q1 What type of field(s) do you mow?

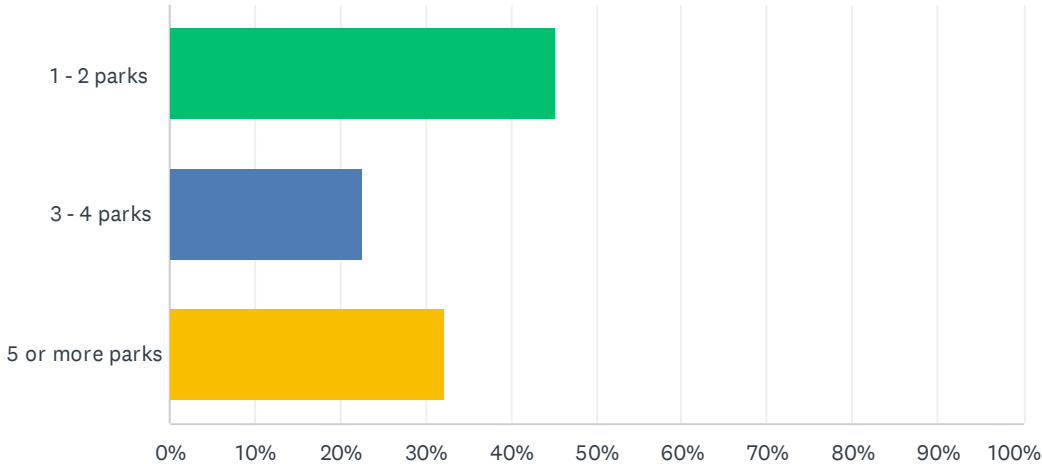

## Q2 How many parks do you mow on your route?

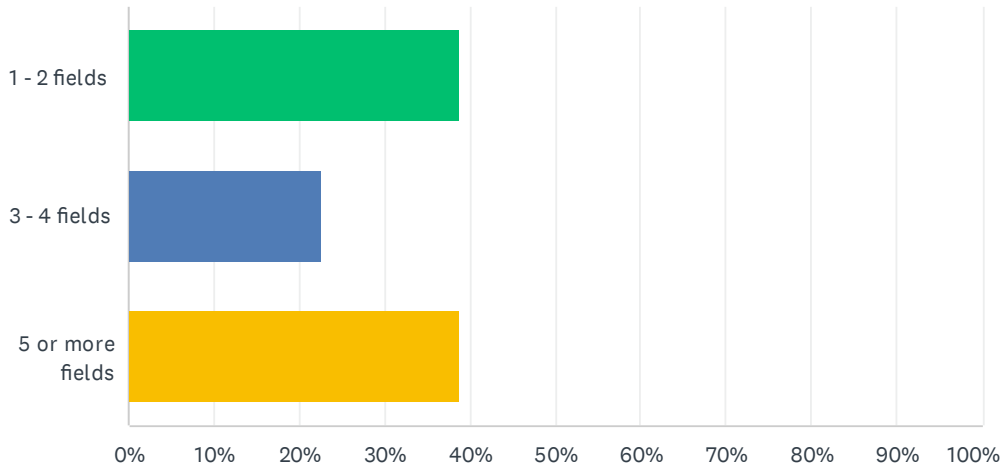

### Q3 On your mowing route how many athletic fields do you mow?

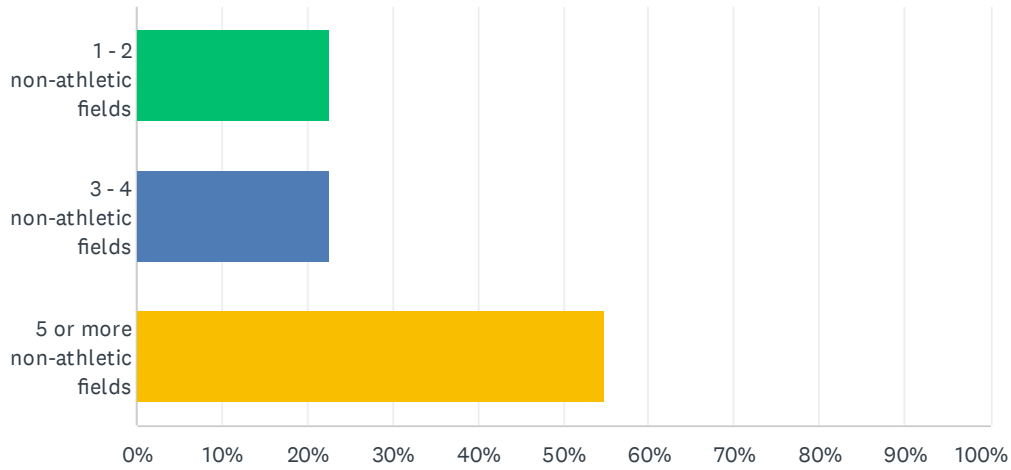

## Q4 On your mowing route how many non-athletic fields do you mow?

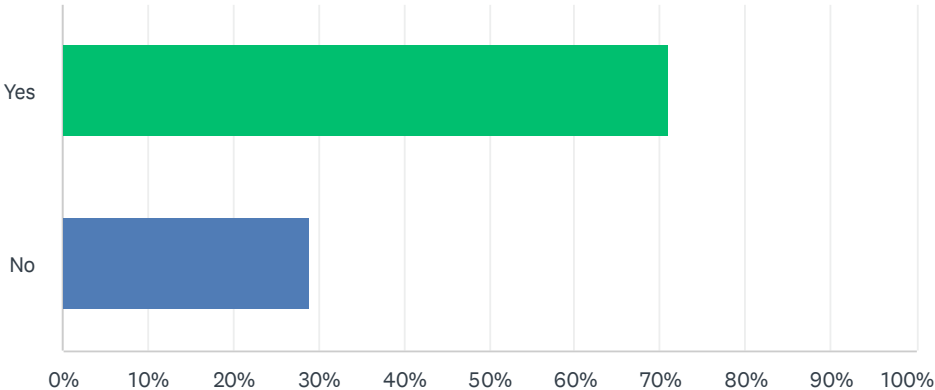

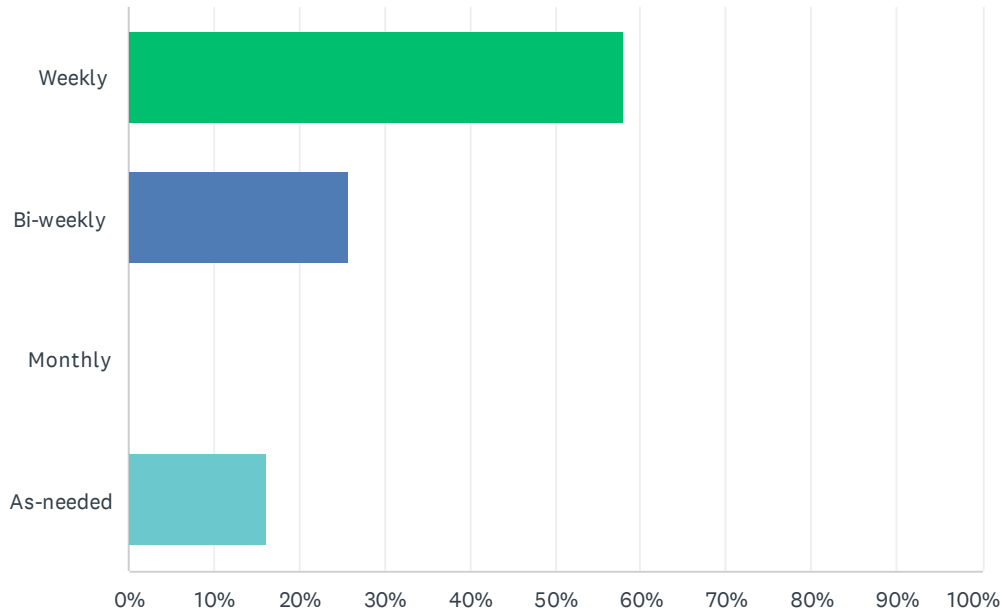

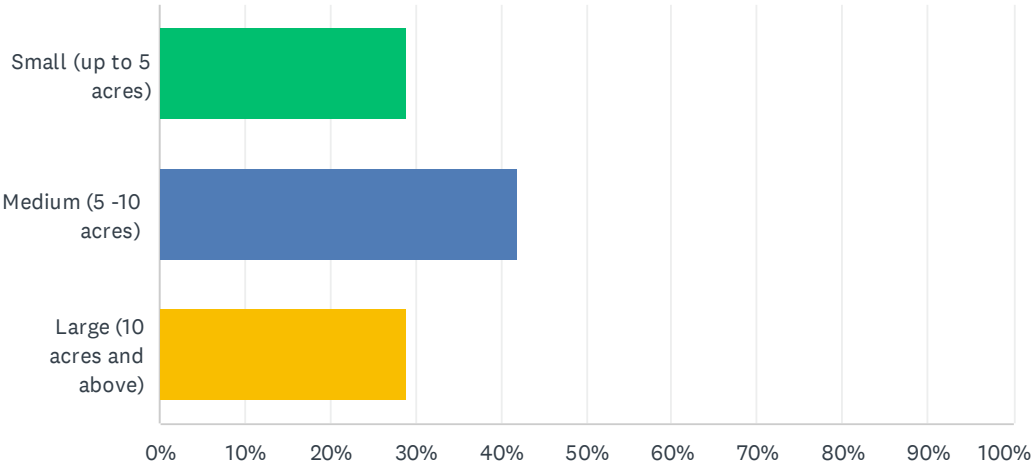

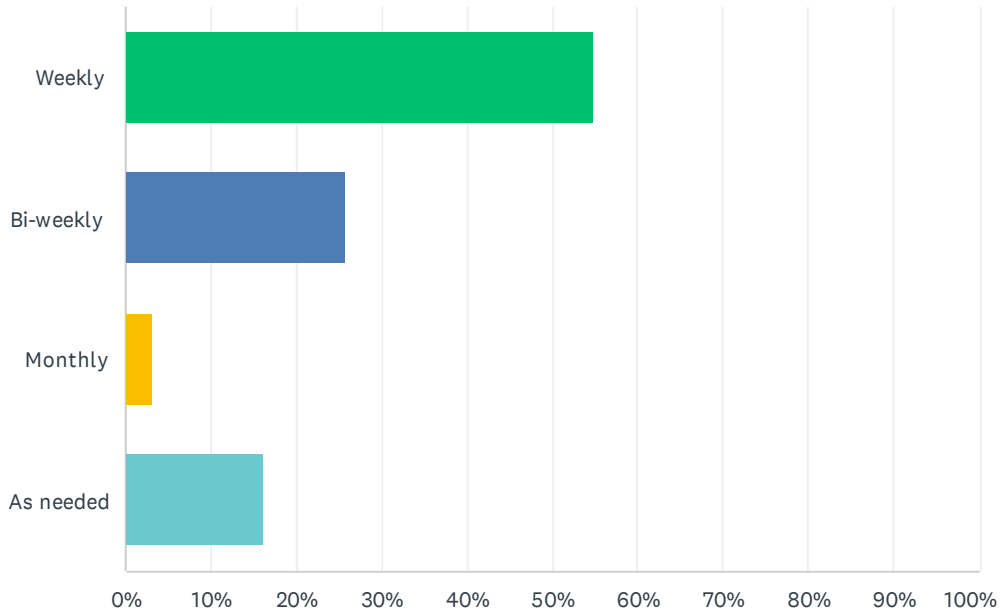

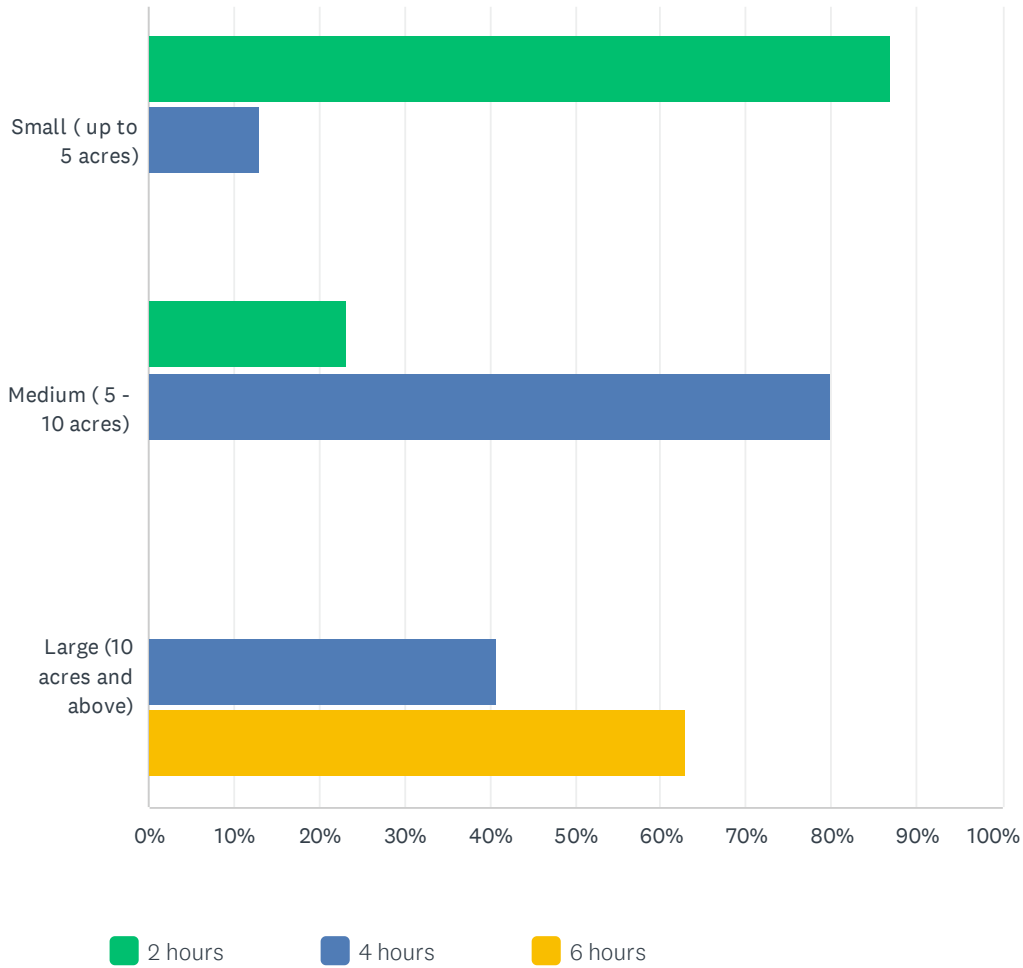

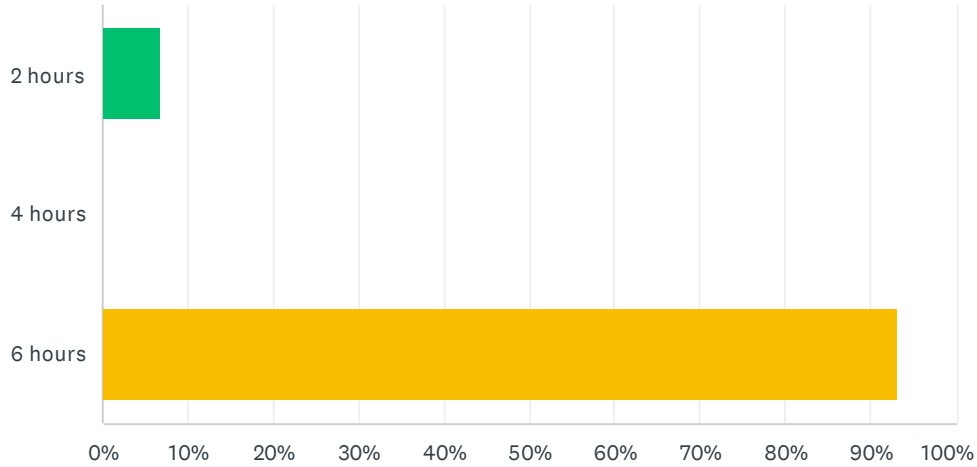

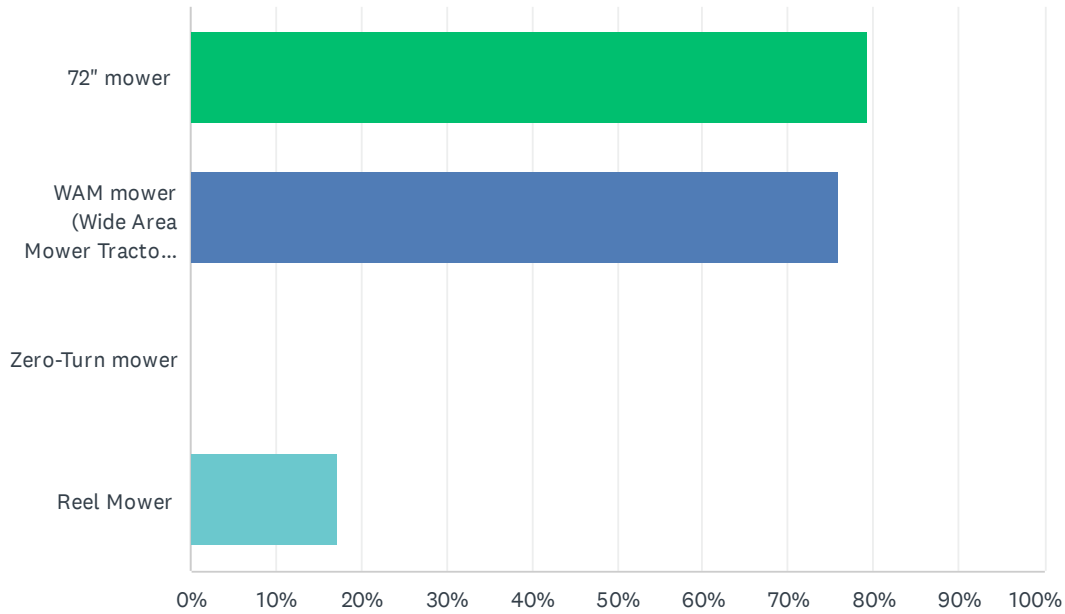

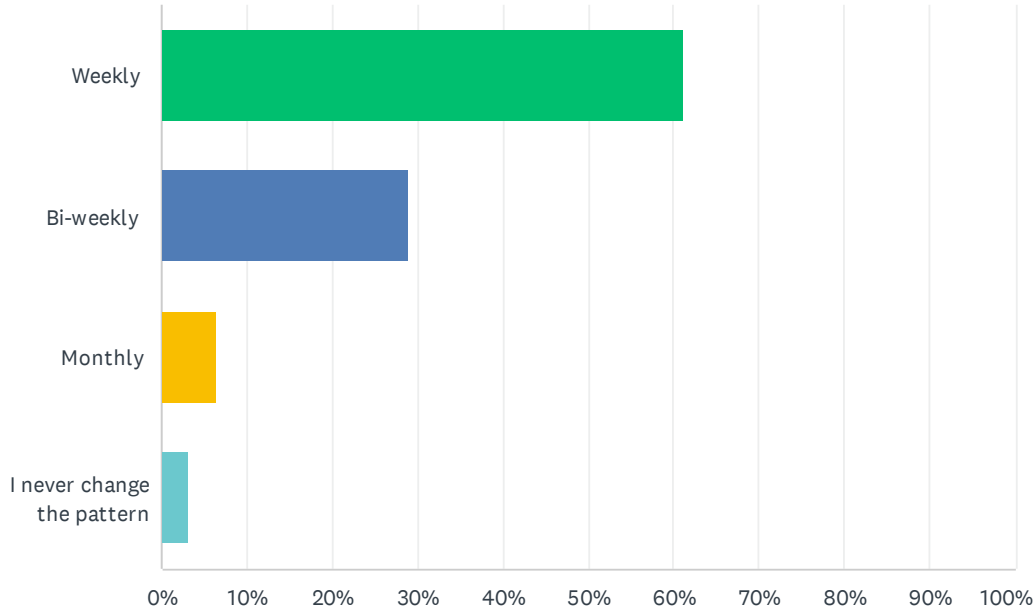

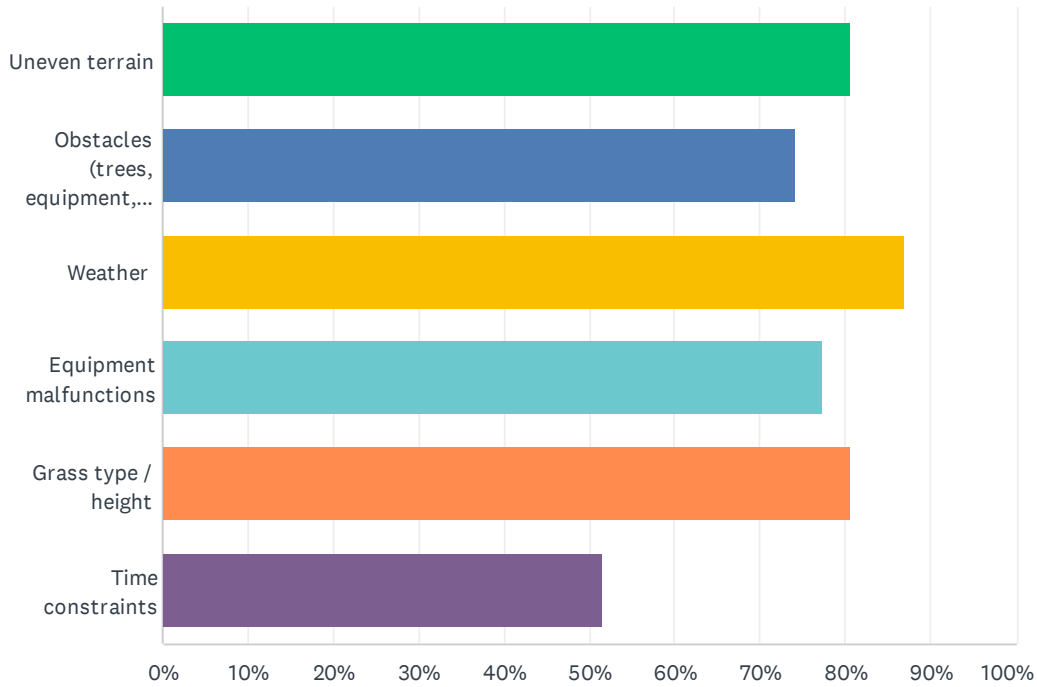

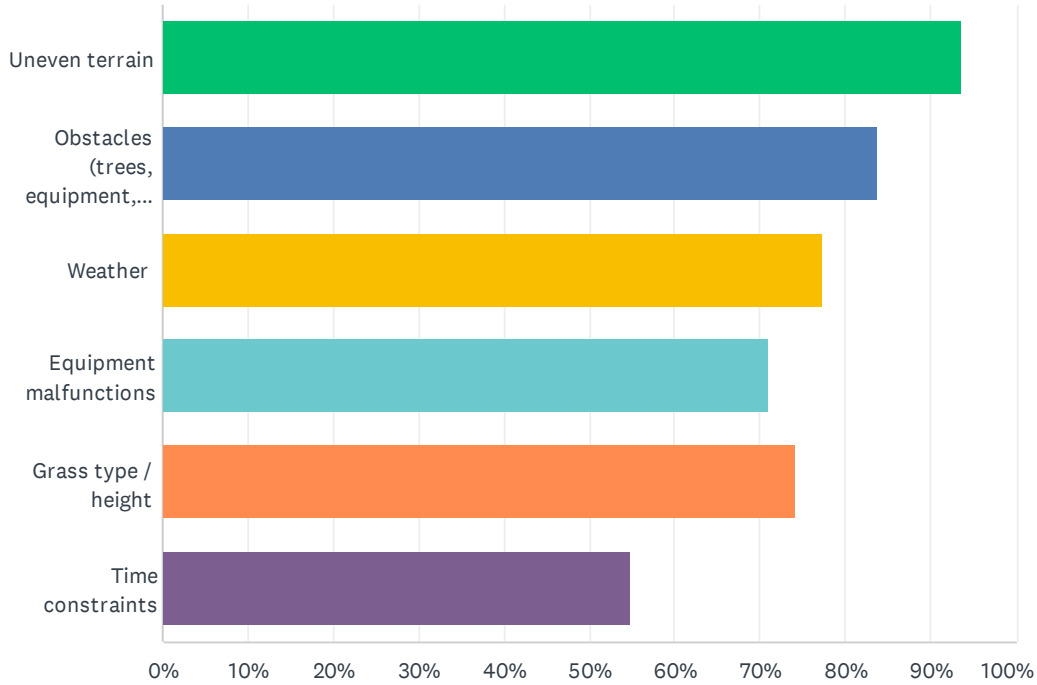

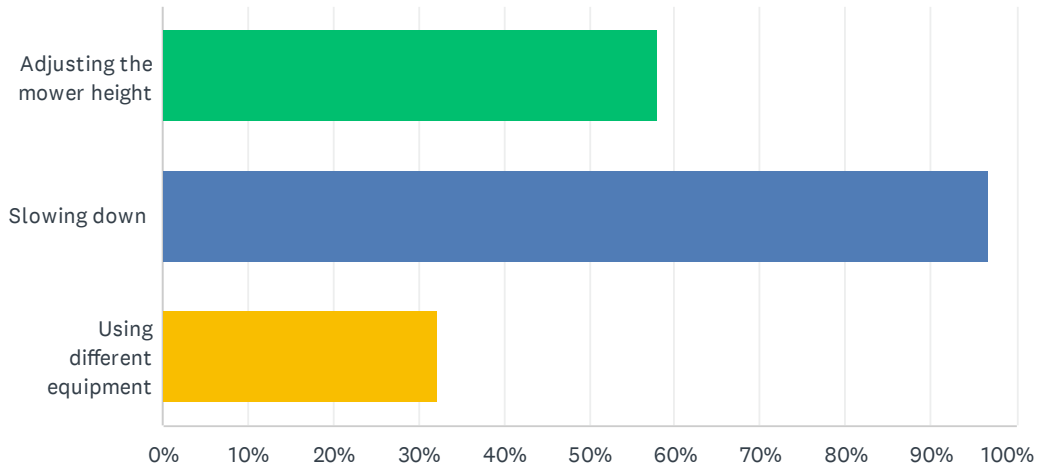

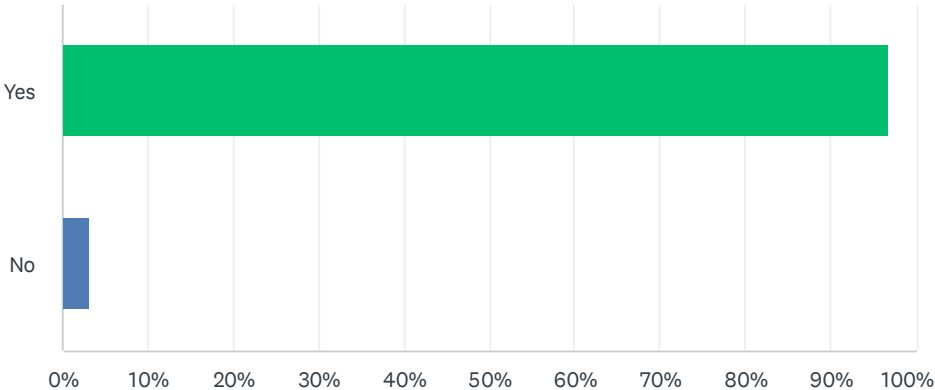

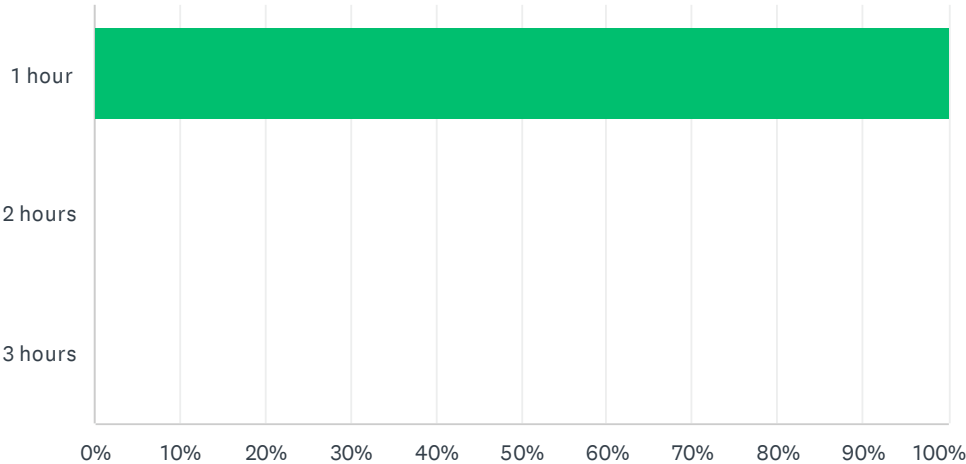

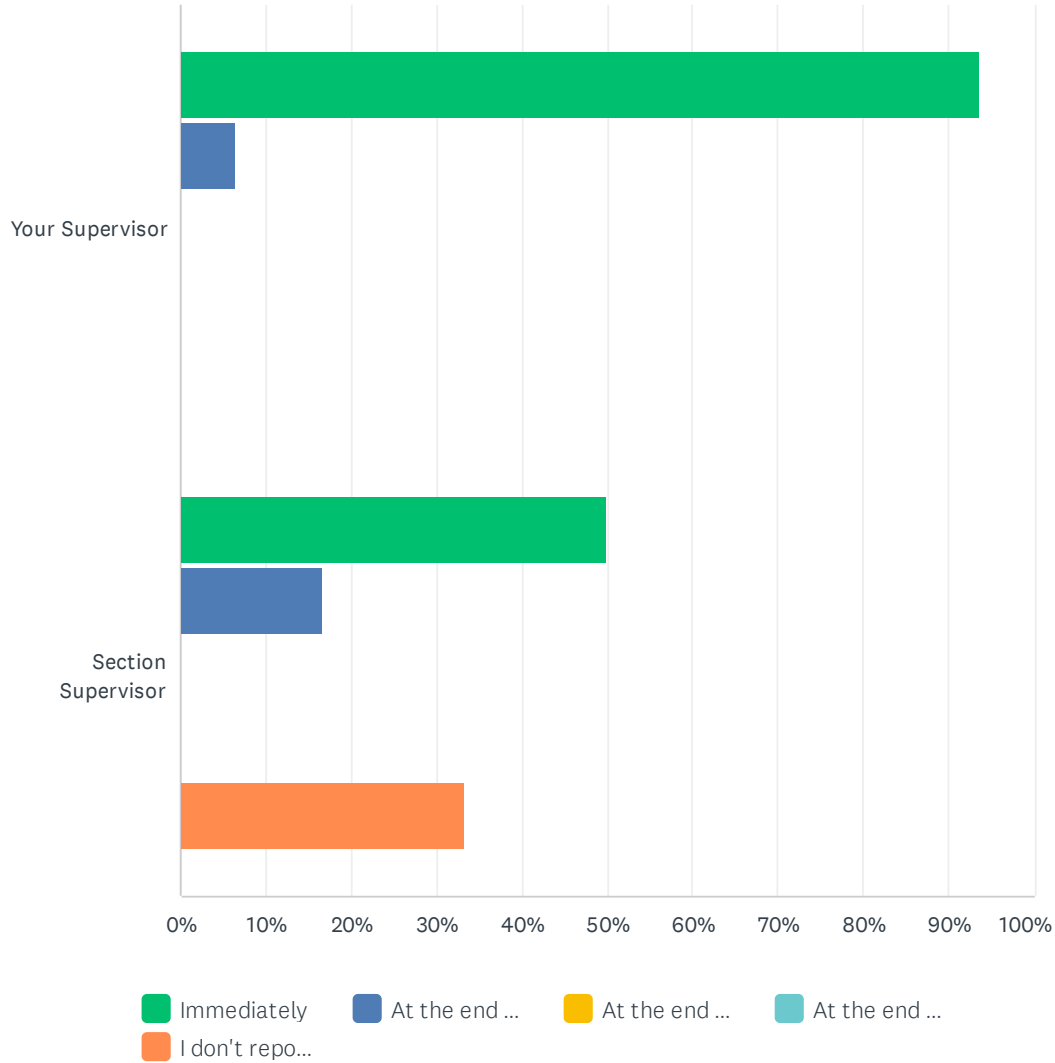

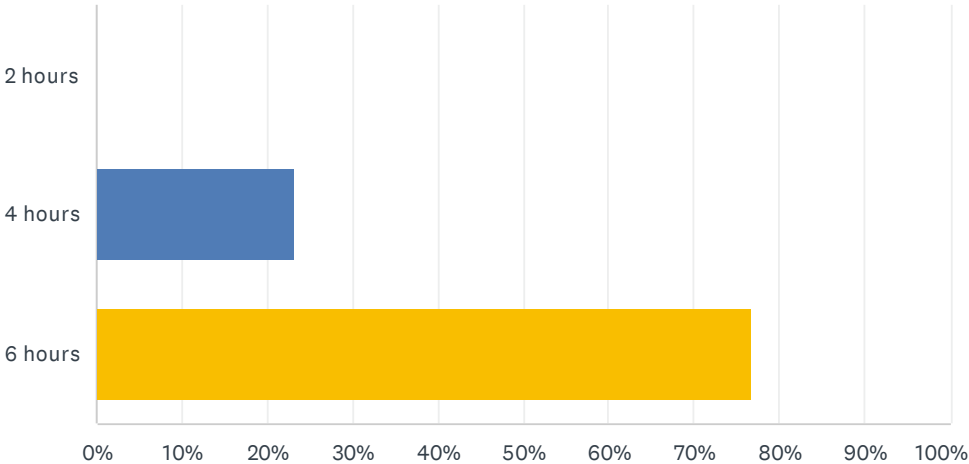

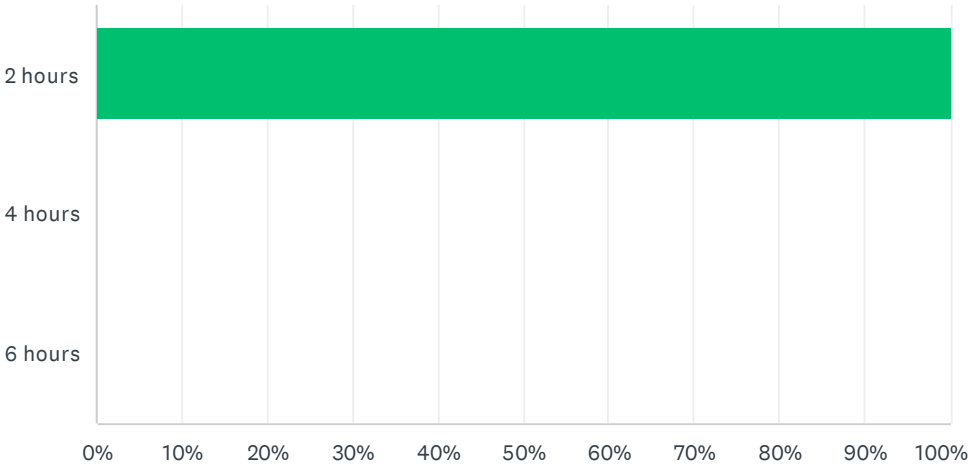
