

FACT SHEET
Councilmember Terms

Councilmembers terms were staggered based upon the number of votes in the 2000 mayoral race. In 2002, the odd numbered council districts were elected to a **TWO-YEAR TERM** and the even numbered districts to a **FOUR-YEAR TERM**.

Pursuant to Revised Charter of the City and County of Honolulu (RCH), Section 3-102, no person shall be elected to the office of council member for more than two consecutive four-year terms.

District V: Scott Nishimoto	2024 / 2032	
District VI: Tyler Dos Santos-Tam	2022 / 2030	
District VII: Radiant Cordero	2020 / 2028	
District VIII: Val Okimoto	2022 / 2030	
District IX: Augie Tulba	2020 / 2028	

Note: Regular terms for Councilmembers commence on January 2 (at the 12:00 meridian) on the year following the regularly scheduled election and end four years later.
