



# Fort Weaver Road Sewer Repairs

## Ewa Area

Fort Weaver Road  
Tentative Construction Dates  
January 2025 – June 2025

### Project Background

A section of sewer pipe within Fort Weaver Road has been damaged and needs to be repaired. The sewer pipe, owned by the City and County of Honolulu Department of Environmental Services (ENV), will be repaired by Frank Coluccio Construction Company, who has been contracted for the project.

### Why Is This Needed?

Damage to this section of the sewer system causes wastewater capacity issues and poses as a potential hazard to the road stability. Although there are no sewage spills to the environment from the damaged lines, the repairs must be made to return the sewer system back to its normal condition.

### When Will This Occur?

Repair work has been progressing intermittently and is tentatively scheduled to be completed by June 2025. To expedite the project's completion, extended daily construction hours, including some holidays and weekends, are planned. Work will start as early as 7:00 a.m. and finish as late as 6:00 p.m. Monday through Friday. If necessary, weekend and holiday work will start as early as 7:00 a.m. and end at 4:00 p.m. The pipeline diversion system will operate continuously until the repairs are finished.

### How Does This Affect You?

Construction will take place along Fort Weaver Road, primarily in the area shaded in blue. While portions of the road may be inaccessible during this time, detour routes and traffic control measures will be in place. Some roadside parking may also be used for construction purposes with the remainder open to the public.

Machinery used during construction may produce moderate noise. The City and County of Honolulu will coordinate with nearby residents before and during construction, if their residences will be affected by any of the work due to excessive noise produced or from changes in traffic control measures.
