The National Citizen Survey[™] reports resident opinions of local government and services with a scientific, representative sample approach. Results are then used to inform budgeting, performance measurement and program planning.

The Voice of the People Awards stand alone as the only award given in local government based on community opinion. The perspectives of the residents themselves determine the very best of community engagement, safety, mobility, foundations of livability, recreation and wellness, education and enrichment, natural environment, built environment and economy.

"This is a unique opportunity to see evidence of best practices quantified by survey results," said NRC president Tom Miller, noting that awarding top jurisdictions can even benefit other communities. "Others can understand the successes of their colleagues and get to know what's working best in America."
