

The City and County of Honolulu's Storm Water Program is composed of eleven City departments which provide essential services and maintain compliance with federal, state, and local directives and regulations.

Under the lead department, the Department of Facility Maintenance, the Storm Water Quality Division and Road Maintenance Division hold the primary supporting roles for this program and provide majority of the services used by the public. The Storm Water Quality Division administers the City's National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System (NPDES) permit and enforces the Revised Ordinances of Honolulu Chapter 43, Article 11. Responsibilities of the eleven departments are described below.
